Greater Los Angeles Education Foundation Awards \$400,000 to 9 Organizations Supporting Inglewood's Youth

INGLEWOOD, CALIFORNIA (October 15, 2025) The Greater Los Angeles Education Foundation (GLAEF) has selected the 2025 cohort of grantees through The Inglewood Youth Education Fund (IYEF) and will commit \$400,000 to expand critical programs and services for youth in Inglewood.

The IYEF was established in the summer of 2024 by GLAEF to provide dedicated resources to organizations serving youth in Inglewood in five critical areas:

- a) After School Tutoring for Inglewood Students
- b) Youth Innovation and Design Camps
- c) Keeping Inglewood Students in School
- d) Opening Pathways to College for Inglewood Students
- e) College Scholarships for Inglewood Students

GLAEF opened its first formal Request for Proposal process in the summer of 2025 and received more than 100 proposals from non-profits, aligned public agencies and grassroots services providers. Based on feedback from an independent advisory committee comprised of Inglewood community leaders, youth, and other local stakeholders, a diverse cohort of programs has been identified. Grants will be awarded to:

1. Musicians at Play, Inc.
2. The Midnight Mission
3. The Los Angeles Philharmonic Association
4. Inglewood Wrapping Arms Around the Community
5. White Hall Arts Academy Foundation
6. Crypto Kids Camp

7. Social Justice Learning Institute
8. Green Dot Public Schools
9. Inglewood Unified School District
